- Treasurer Report, OLan Kaigel: Beginning Balance of \$31,136.92, ending balance of \$51,198.00. We still have outstanding checks to be cashed from the Tamale Festival.
- LakeFest/Tamale Festival: Nancy Hair: The Tamale Festival was a huge success for the City, for our organization and the Zoo. Both organizations netted \$15,556,91. The date change to May and the beautiful weather contributed to an amazing event. We are grateful to the City for giving us this opportunity. LakeFest is a "fun" raiser not a "fund" raiser. Friends of Atascadero Lake and the Link Family Resource Center each netted \$1063.00. It was such a fun day and so many amazing boats entered the race.
