- Treasurer's Report, Olan Kaigel: September 2017 beginning balance of \$9,027.73, \$940.28 debits, \$266.64 credits leaving a balance of \$9,123.67. October beginning balance of \$9,123.67 debits of \$1,537.62 (2 PG&E bills), credits of \$6,750.36 leaving a balance of \$14,158.41. Olan mentioned that Sesloc needs the minutes from this meeting.
- Pipeline Repair, Paul Murphy: The city has completed repairs under San Gabriel Rd. and almost completed repairs just east of the intake. They have constructed two manhole access points along with sleeving the pipe. We are all ready for the rain and very appreciative of the work.
