



## Minutes from the July 18, 2017 Board Meeting of Friends of Atascadero Lake

- Treasurer's Report, Olan Kaigel: Beginning balance of \$13, 597, deposits of \$235.30, withdrawals of \$704.73 leaving an ending balance of \$13,126.17
- Pipeline Repair by City, Paul Murphy: At the time of the meeting we had not heard from Nick Debar about progress. To update, Paul heard from Nick and they have not started on repairs. Paul mentioned that the city originally wanted to have needed repairs done by September. We are hoping that all repairs are done before winter rains to insure a good flow of water into the lake over the winter months.
- Lake Perimeter Clean up, Jon Trumbull: Jon will contact Bob Joslin from the city about dates for our annual fall clean up. Once he has the date he will contact the Conservation Corps about helping as they did last year.
- Saturday Barbeque at the lake August 15<sup>th</sup>, Paul Murphy: We are partnering with The Veterans Memorial Foundation as we did last year. We talked about volunteers for the evening, our responsibilities and the necessity of selling more tickets. We need volunteers to be there for the 2 hours. You will help for an hour and then get an hour to eat dinner. We are responsible for the cleanup. You can purchase tickets from us or go the Atascadero Chamber on El Camino and purchase tickets to benefit Friends of Atascadero Lake. We do get to sell tickets at the park on the 8<sup>th</sup> for next week.
- Dancing with Our Stars, Nancy Hair: We are very excited to announce that we were chosen to participate in Atascadero's favorite event. Karen Burish-Wyke will be our dancer. This is quite an opportunity for us to earn much needed funds. The project we will be funding is signage around the lake.
- Solar for the well, Paul Murphy: Paul has talked with Solarponics and to run the well efficiently an array of solar panels 20' x 20' would be required. This well is on private land so we are still exploring possibilities. We currently would not have enough money to do a project of this scope even if granted permission from the land owner.
- Paddleboat Concession: We are owed a balance form the concessionaire. Right now, we want to work towards a solution. We had been asked to help man the concession and some board members agreed. No one was contacted or called on to help.
