- Approval of the August 19, 2021, Board Meeting Minutes
- LakeFest 2022: Lisa Fraser and Josh Bustamonte from The Link Family Resource Center came to our meeting to introduce themselves. In 2022 we will be partnering with “The Link” for LakeFest. In the past “The Link” held Children’s Day in The Park yearly at Atascadero Lake Park. We are looking forward to the collaboration between the two non-profits to put on a nice family focus event. This will introduce all the wonderful resources San Luis Obispo County has to help families while also promoting Atascadero Lake.
- Treasurer’s Report, Olan Kaigel: Beginning balance of \$27,322.40, deposits \$2,190.00, withdrawals \$896.56 leaving an ending balance of \$28,615.84. We also talked about doing something special for our donors.
- Amendment of the By-Laws, Mark Hontz: Nancy Hair called numerous lawyers regarding helping us add an indemnity clause. Two responded favorably with quoting a price of around \$1000. Because we did not have a quorum it was not voted on, although attending board members felt it was a good idea to have a lawyer look over and adjust the by-laws.
- Lake Perimeter Clean Up, Nancy Hair: We are all set for Saturday the 23rd. The city will have dumpsters, tools and a city employee to help.
- Up-coming Events, Nancy Hair: Atascadero Fall Festival will go from Nov 19-21. Mark and Kathy, Paul, Bob and Michael will be volunteering on Nov 20th from 11-3. The Tamale Festival is Jan 15th 11-7. Again, we will be responsible for selling the drink tickets.
- Round Table: Kathy Hontz will investigate the “Adopt a Highway” program. We all agreed having our organization name out there is a good idea. Our two lake path signs on the history of Atascadero Lake have been installed and we had our “Ribbon Cutting” with the City Council on Friday October 16th.
