- Treasurer's Report, Olan Kaigel: Beginning balance, \$35,675.52, Deposits, \$1,620.00, Withdrawals, \$1029.13, leaving and ending balance of: \$36,266.39
- Lake Perimeter Clean Up, Nancy Hair: Clean-up is Saturday, October 24<sup>th</sup>. We have been actively looking for more youth volunteers. We have contacted The Boy Scouts, Atascadero High School, and The ABC Church. We are hoping there will be a large turn out as there is much work to be accomplished.
