



Minutes from the Friends of Atascadero Lake Board Meeting October 20, 2015

- Meeting called to order by Paul Murphy
- Approval of minutes from the September 15th, 2015 Board meeting
- Treasure's report/Joni Walter: No credits, no debits. Balance of \$29,710.97
- Introduction of Terrie Banish, Deputy City Manager for events for the City of Atascadero. Friends of Atascadero Lake is planning a Lake Fest Event for 2016 to celebrate the lake and bring people back to the lake. We are excited to have Terrie help us plan this amazing event. She suggested we make a list for the festivities, involve other organizations. More information to follow on this.
- Atascadero Chamber Expo: Joni Walter and Pam Pascal created an awesome booth for us and we made many new "Lake Friends". It was definitely a networking opportunity and worthwhile.
- PG&E pole installation at well: Paul Murphy let us know like all projects this has taken a bit longer. We are waiting for a new electrical box to mount on the pole to complete the project.
- Well to Lake pipeline: We are on revision 3 of the plans. The line will be a combination of boring underground and some trenching. All will take place in the city right of way. We have recently found out from the city we need to obtain 3 new permits for the project and with help from the city, we are working on those now.
- Meeting with city staff: Paul Murphy, Don Lynge, Nancy Hair and Jon Trumbull met with Rachelle Richard, Nick DeBar and Bob Joslin to update each other on ongoing projects. We do this about every 4 months or so. We are getting a lot of support from the city on the perimeter clean up with use of staff, and placement of dumpsters. The city has made a small repair to the pipe from the creek which will help this winter.
- Board of Realtors: Paul Murphy and Nancy Hair spoke before the Board of Realtors. A comment was made that when the lake was in its prime the first thing a realtor would do was to drive the prospective client to the lake, now they try and avoid it. They asked many great questions.
- City Council report: Barbara Combs went to the City Council meeting to thank the city for their support for our projects and to stress the importance of a clean and beautiful Atascadero Lake. She also reminded the council of the history of the lake and how it has always been integral and synonymous with the city.
- Lake Perimeter Clean Up: Jon Trumbull says we are all ready and everything is in place. The board members will be bringing muffins to share in the morning.
- Atascadero Chamber Executive Committee: Paul Murphy and Nancy Hair met with them to update them on current and future projects. Some of their members are relatively new to Atascadero so they were very interested in the lake and its history.

- Colony Days Float: Bob Edmonds helped organize the float and Don Lynge donated use of his car for the float. It was a fun project and we received a lot of support along the parade route. Check it out on our website!
- Paddle Boat business: Joni Walter researched this idea and it was brought to our attention that this model does not fit in with our Mission Statement.
- Kiosk Report: Don Lynge reported that the holes are dug and the posts should be in soon. The target date for the final assembly is October 31st.
