



Minutes from the January 19th, 2018 Friends of Atascadero Lake Board Meeting

- Approval of the November 21, 2017 Board Meeting minutes
- Treasurer's Report/Olan Kaigel: Beginning balance Nov 01, 2017 \$8,323.34, deposits of \$7,197.46, withdrawals of \$ 1,291.44. Leaving an ending balance of \$14,229.36. December deposits of \$1,225.99, withdrawals of \$720.00 leaving an ending balance of \$14,735.35.
- Tamale Festival/Paul Murphy: The Tamale Festival went very well. We really appreciate all the folks who volunteered. We are grateful to the city for giving this opportunity.
- Dancing with Our Stars/Nancy Hair: We have given the DWOS committee our list of volunteers. We still need silent auction items by mid-February. (one per each board member). Tom O'Malley has offered up his beautiful Portola Inn for a free fundraiser to be held February 19th, 2:30-3:30. Co-hosted by Heather Moreno and Steve Martin and Maria Goldman has offered to pour her delicious Frolicking Frog Cellars wine. There will be a dance preview by our Community Star dancer Karen Burish Wyke and her choreographer partner Tom Troxel and a dance preview by Jim Wilkins (Historical Society) and his choreographer partner Christina Troxel.
- LakeFest 2018/Nancy Hair: LakeFest is coming along. We already have vendors signing up, music and entertainment in place, Beer Garden will be split between the Optimists Club and Friends of Atascadero Lake, all beer donated by Pacific Beverage! Sponsorship flyers are done (Thank you Annie Wilson of Grape Encounters Emporium who designed the beautiful art work) and will be placed in the next Atascadero Chamber paper. The Paddleboard company of Morro Bay will again be bringing his stand-up paddleboards, thank you Ken Twist. We decided to ask \$10.00 from each boat being made to defer costs. Vernon of Stylin Graphics in Atascadero has changed the banner for the lake park and the ones for Ads on The Wall at the Galaxy Theater, Atascadero.
- Pedal Boat Rental/Paul Murphy: Rob Andrus who runs the Peddle boat concession wanted to know if we wanted to rent out his equipment on the summer Tuesday night barbeques in the park to help pay off his debt to us. Nobody volunteered to do this as we felt the Tuesday night barbeque crowd would not be the demographics that would rent boats.
- City Grant Money/Paul Murphy: Paul Murphy sent a letter to the City Council asking for \$30,000 as part of their grant money for Atascadero Lake Park funds to pay for phase two of the Aeration System. He will follow up with the mayor.
- Round Table: We are concerned with the island and the dead trees along the perimeter. The island needs cleaning up. There is a bit of water flowing in the creek up at the Three Bridges Trail, but not enough to flow into the pipe. Marilyn Pieters set up a donation site on Facebook for the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation for "Giving Tuesday". If you qualify The Gates Foundation would match your donations up to \$100,000,000. There were very specific rules. We were sent a check for \$300. Thank you, Marilyn, for doing the work.
